**LESSON PLAN 3** 

Syedpur to Sunderland: A Storyline Teaching Model for Cultural Exchange and Migration Lesson Plan: Episode 3 Explore and Develop knowledge of Syedpur village through people and places.

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This session will be supported by local volunteers from The Bangladesh Community; A list of question/ prompts for the group to ask the interviewees. There are also a number of video links referenced that can support this learning and understanding of the locality.
